PROGRAMMING SAFETY PLAN

We would like to welcome you back to in-person programming! Our priority is the health and safety of our public and our staff. With that in mind, our programming may look a bit different and programming may return in different capacities or at different times. We thank you for your patience as we work to find the best way to safely serve you during this transition and we look forward to offering more options.

MASKS

All program attendees ages 8 and up or those attending a program for school age or up are required to wear a mask. Masks are available at our desks if you forget yours.

CLEANING

To ensure the health and safety of our patrons and programmers, all of our program spaces will be cleaned on a regular basis. Program supplies will be used individually rather than shared and will be disinfected or disposed. Hand sanitizer will be available at each program and patrons are welcome to request gloves, as well. As always, hand washing will be encouraged.

SPACES & ATTENDANCE

We will space attendees out to a minimum of 3 feet and ask them to practice social distancing. Programs will be at reduced capacity and an attendance list will be kept to assist in contact tracing, if requested by the Board of Health.
